MON THONG

"Ogopogo" the Okanagan Lake Monster

This legendary lake monster lives in Okanagan Lake which stretches 79 miles long and is at its widest, 2.12 miles wide. The Native Americans name "Nataka" means "The Lake Monster." The current name "Ogopogo" came from a comical parody of the creature.

Documented reports of the monster have been common since the 1920s. Sometimes involving 50 to 60 people. Most people describe the "Ogopogo" as a long, snake like creature that swims with 5 or more humps appearing above the water. The head is reported to have horns and shaped like a horse. In 1936 one report describes it as big around as a "telephone pole", and that the color was "dark and fishlike". No scientific investigation of the monster has been made.

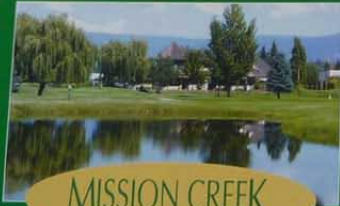

Sipping into beautiful Okanagan Wine Country

"Up into something beautiful..." - Jessica Paine Terrence, owner of Okanagan Wine Country Tours. "The location is too incredible to ignore. With more than 80 wineries in the Okanagan, it's difficult to decide which ones to visit, so we've tried them all. Paine has conducted tours for honeymooners, local groups and visitors from all over the world. Her two-hour tour called A Beautiful Delight begins with Paine behind the wheel of her luxurious vehicle picking up guests at their hotel to visit three wineries located on the west side of Kelowna.

Masson Hill Family Estate Winery is perched on the top of a mountain with magnificent architecture that is visible for miles around the valley. This extraordinary winery is being completed millions of dollars in expansion, including private dining rooms, gourmet food services, and a large outdoor amphitheatre to provide additional entertainment for visitors.

Located just below Masson Hill is Quail's Gate Estate Winery. This charming winery offers a beautiful view of both Okanagan Lake and the east vineyards. A fairly new addition to the winery is the Old Spice Patio, where you can stop for a leisurely lunch. Sitting in the sun, enjoying the spectacular view, and sipping on one of Quail's Gate's specialty wines to complement a delicious meal is a fine example of what the Okanagan has to offer.

Not far away from Quail's Gate is Little Bear Estate Winery. Known as a "Burgundy" winery due to its smaller size of wine production, this type of winery is always fun to visit, as more often than not you're either meeting the grower or the winemaker, or both. A sample of their delicious Australian Pinot is always a great treat.

Wine touring is an excellent way to visit the local wineries. Having someone else do the driving allows for a more relaxing pace, plus it's always a good idea to drink when you're driving. Tours are available for all sizes of groups, all ranges of budgets and all types of special events. Corporate groups often enjoy an organized private tour featuring an exclusive vineyard dinner. Plus a two-night package including accommodation and a full day of wine touring is also available through Okanagan Wine Country Tours.

Okanagan Lake Bridge was opened in July 1906, 1958 and operated as a toll bridge until April 1st, 1968. This bridge is the only structure in Canada, and one of the few of its kind in the world. A new bridge to replace it opened in July 2008.

The overall length from shore to shore is 7/8 of a mile. A typical section of the pontoon is 50 feet wide and 15 feet in depth, being submerged about 8

feet. Ten typical pontoons of 200 feet length, and two end pontoons of 50 feet length make up the 2000 feet length. The pontoons are connected together so act as a continuous unit, 2100 feet long. The lift span is 265 feet long and can be raised to provide 60 feet of vertical clearance. Each pontoon has two anchors, one on each side, for a total of 24 anchors. Each anchor weighs 70 tons, and is embedded 25 feet into the lake bottom.

KVR Railway Trestles

High in the mountains immediately south of Kelowna is a picturesque trail resulting from the abandonment of the rail line and removal of the tracks in the early 1980's. This section of the rail bed passing through Myra Canyon is part of the Kettle Valley Railway (KVR) completed in 1916 and connects with the CPR Trunk at Hope and Midway to provide a direct rail link from the southern interior to the coast. This 12 kilometer long section is popular for hiking and cycling. A level grade makes it a comfortable ride or walk along a rail bed carved into the mountainside presenting many beautiful viewpoints. Several of the trestles are covered with a boardwalk and railings were damaged in a fire in 2003 and are currently being rebuilt.



The Kettle Valley Railway trestles are a popular place for visitors to hike and cycle with spectacular views of Myra canyon and Kelowna. In the fire of 2003 total of 12 of the 18 trestles in the Myra canyon were destroyed by fire, leaving 4 wooden trestles undamaged and 2 steel trestle gull structures but damaged. All of the trestles have been rebuilt with work being completed in June 2008. There are two areas for viewing. Use



the Little White Forest Service road, from McCulloch Rd. to a parking lot and walk to trestle #1. Alternatively if you go up the Myra Forest Service road from McCulloch Rd. This route will get you to the most trestles. For information see the Tour listings in this directory tour information and for bike rentals.

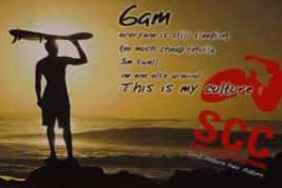

GREENWAY TRAIL THROUGH THE HEART OF KELOWNA

One of the most popular park experiences in Kelowna is the Mission Creek Greenway trail that travels right through the heart of Kelowna for a distance of about 7.5 kilometres. An average of 1,000 visitors a day utilize the trail on the bank of Mission Creek to enjoy a truly wilderness experience and to see a variety of birds, animals and fish. The trail starts at Lakeshore Road (just past the City's Lakeshore Boat Launch site), and ends at Springfield and Zipeck Road (about 1 kilometre beyond Orchard Park Shopping Centre). Other access points are at the City's Gordon Drive sportsfields, Casorso Road, KLO Road, the Mission Creek Regional Park on Springfield, and at Zipeck Road. There is no charge for use of the trail and it is suitable for walkers, bicyclists, wheelchair users and equestrians. The trail is level and suitable for all ages. The Greenway was achieved through the generosity of many landowners who donated land, and the citizens of Kelowna who donated more than \$700,000 to the project.



The Greenway is a project of the Friends of Mission Creek Society whose purpose include the preservation of the Mission Creek environment for future generations. Enjoy your visit!
